



PLAY Project Consultant Certification Online Course Overview

PLAY Project's 6-week Online Certification Course is the second step in the Certification process, following the Intensive Workshop. The goal of the course is to fully prepare the PLAY Project Consultant Trainee to master the PLAY Project approach.

Each week, participants will complete an average of 1-2 hours of course work, including recorded and (optional) live sessions, written reports, and reading assignments.

Overview

Unit 1: Introduction & Orientation

This unit will explain the goal of certification training, list the weekly course activities, describe the topics for each unit of the online course, and give examples of course resources and support.

Unit 2: Written Reports

Live Session

Participants learn to give effective, parent-friendly written feedback, so they can prepare caregivers to help their young child with autism move up in their functional development.

Unit 3: Assessments

This unit will introduce participants to a variety of tools for assessment of the child, the caregiver, and for Teaching PLAY trainees, the classroom environment.

Unit 4: Implementation

Live Session

This unit describes the various settings and delivery models for PLAY Intervention and Teaching PLAY, policies and expectations of PLAY Implementation, and available resources.

Unit 5: Supervision

This unit explains the supervision process, including supervision tasks, their requirements, and how to complete them.

Unit 6: Administration

Live Session

This unit will describe PLAY Project licensing, introduce marketing and outreach tools for the trainee and organization, and help plan outreach and implementation for the trainee.
