Licensing Benefits Details and Policies

Number of Active PLAY Project Consultants: Individuals or organizations with 1-3 PLAY Project Consultants (PPC) can choose the PLAY Organization Plus license in order to gain added benefits.

Permission to use PLAY Project name: The PLAY Project® name has received formal trademark registration from the US Patent & Trademark Office. Professionals and organizations who implement the PLAY Project autism intervention model have permission to use our name, logo, and program materials under our licensing agreement.

Listed as provider on playproject.org: A listing with provider contact information helps clients to find your organization when searching for autism services in their area.

Access to most up-to-date materials: All active PPCs and relevant administrators can download electronic versions of the most current program, administration, and marketing materials on Sharefile.com.

4 free live webinars with Dr. Solomon per year: Live quarterly webinars are typically scheduled at noon EST, and are recorded and archived for those who cannot attend. Active PPCs will be notified by email to register (so be sure to keep us updated on your most current email address!).
